- > 2019: Placement under criminal title 12-21 Yrs

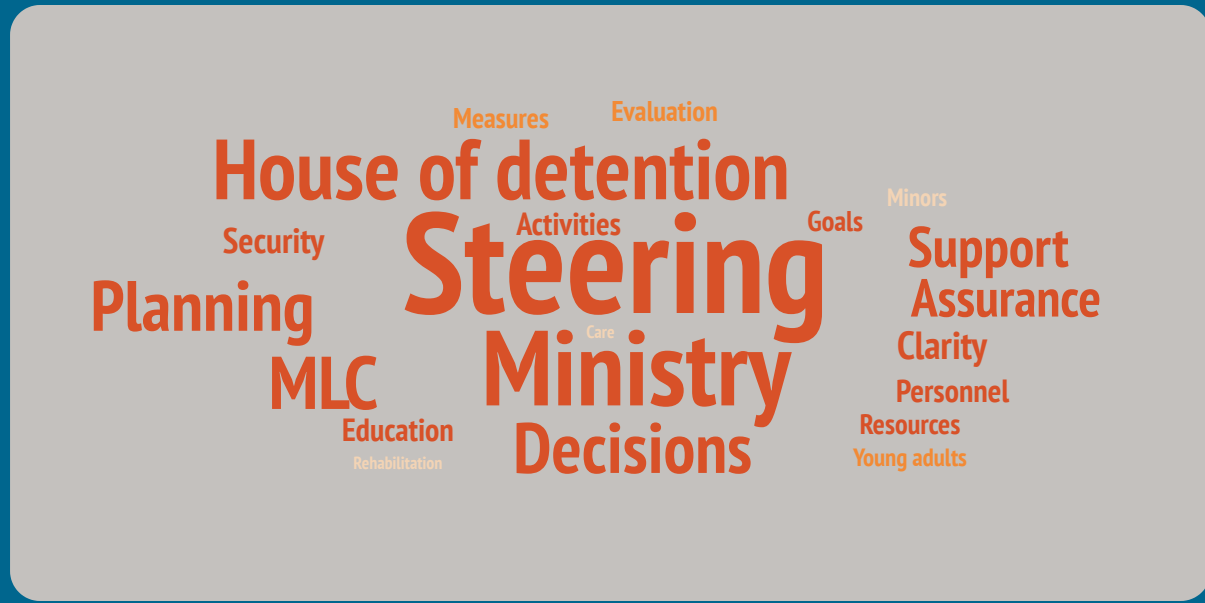
